You are hereby informed that we may use cookies on your device, providing that you give us your consent.

In the event you provide your consent, **Vela Nomada** will use its own and third-party cookies to improve the features on **www.velanomada.com**, to improve our services and to personalise and analyse your browsing behaviour on our website. We would like to clearly and accurately inform you about the cookies we use, and shall describe what cookies are, what they are for, what type of cookies we use, what their ultimate purpose is and how you can configure or disable cookies.

We never store our users' personal details, with the exception of the IP address as described below.

Accepting the use of cookies and browsing and continuing to use our website implies your consent to the conditions set forth in this Cookies Policy.

What are cookies and what are they used for?

A cookie is a small file that is stored on users' computer, tablet, smartphone and other internet browsing devices.

Together, cookies help us to enhance the quality of our website, manage which pages are useful, which are not and which ones we can improve.

Cookies perform essential functions in the internet, delivering a series of advantages in terms of providing interactive services, enhanced browsing and the usability of our website.

Cookies cannot damage your device. On the contrary, active cookies help us to identify and resolve certain problems.

What type of cookies do we use?

According to the managing company:

- First-party cookies: These are cookies that our own computers or domains send to your device from our own computers or domains and which helps us provide our services.
- Third-party cookies: These are cookies that are sent to your device from a domain other than ours. For example, cookies managed by social media sites or external content such as Google Maps.

According to the time they remain active:

- Session cookies: These are temporary cookies that remain in the browser until you
 leave the website, and consequently they do not remain on your device's hard drive.
 The information obtained via these cookies is used to analyse website traffic. These
 cookies allow us to improve the contents of our website and facilitate its use in the
 long term.
- Persistent cookies: These cookies are stored on the device hard drive and our
 website locates them whenever you visit our website. A persistent cookie has a
 specific expiry date and is invalid after that date. These cookies are generally used to
 provide shopping and registration services.

According to the purpose:

 Technical cookies: These cookies are essential for the correct browsing and functioning of our website. For example, they make it possible to control traffic and data communication, access restricted contents, facilitate purchasing processes, use security features, store contents for sharing videos or content via social media.

International Data Transfer:

Users are hereby informed that the use of cookies belonging to the domain of a third-party ad network, to the extent that they belong to sites hosted in countries with a level of personal data protection that does not align with European Union standards, may involve an international data transfer.
